





Viewing Clinical Documents in My Health Record

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

| <p>STEP 1:</p> <p>To access the patient’s My Health Record, select the Open My Health Record drop-down menu, then select View Health Record Overview.</p> |  |
| <p>STEP 2:</p> <p>Scroll down and click on the Patient Document List shortcut tile.</p> |  |
| <p>STEP 3:</p> <p>The Patient Document List will display. You can filter the document list by Document Type and Date Range. Once you have selected the relevant filters, select OK then Refresh.</p> |  |
| <p>STEP 4:</p> <p>To ensure the most recent documents are displayed at the top of the list, click on the sort arrow next to Document Date. Alternatively, you can display the documents within the list alphabetically by clicking on the sort arrow next to Document.</p> <p>To open a document, double-click on it.</p> |  |

STEP 5:

To save a document select **Print**, select **PDF Writer** (or equivalent) as the printer and click **Print**. Save the PDF to a secure location in your local system.
